

# Classifying Pocono Habitats

1. Cut out the picture cards.
2. Using the key provided, identify each habitat and write that name on the back of the picture card.
3. Sort the habitats into the following four categories and write the category on the back of the picture card:
  1. Terrestrial: Land
  2. Wetland: Swamps and similar
  3. Lentic: Still Water (lakes and ponds)
  4. Lotic: Moving Water (rivers and creeks)
4. On the back of each picture card provide a Pocono example of that habitat (i.e. Delaware River, Tannersville Cranberry Bog)
5. Staple the cards in the form of a booklet
