- 1. Cut out the picture cards.
- 2. Using the key provided, identify each habitat and write that name on the back of the picture card.
- 3. Sort the habitats into the following four categories and write the category on the back of the picture card:
 - 1. Terrestrial: Land
 - 2. Wetland: Swamps and similar
 - 3. Lentic: Still Water (lakes and ponds)
 - 4. Lotic: Moving Water (rivers and creeks)
- 4. On the back of each picture card provide a Pocono example of that habitat (i.e. Delaware River, Tannersville Cranberry Bog)
- 5. Staple the cards in the form of a booklet
