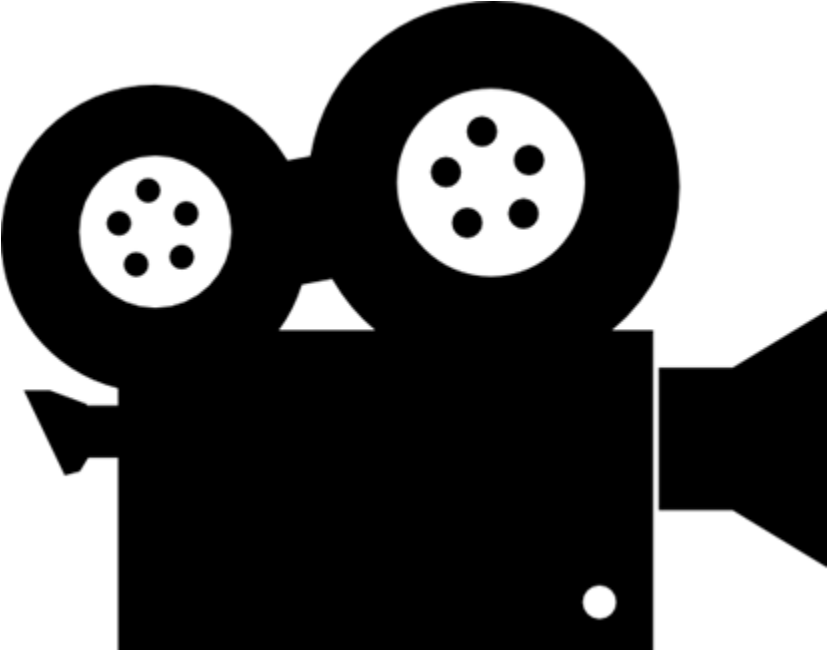
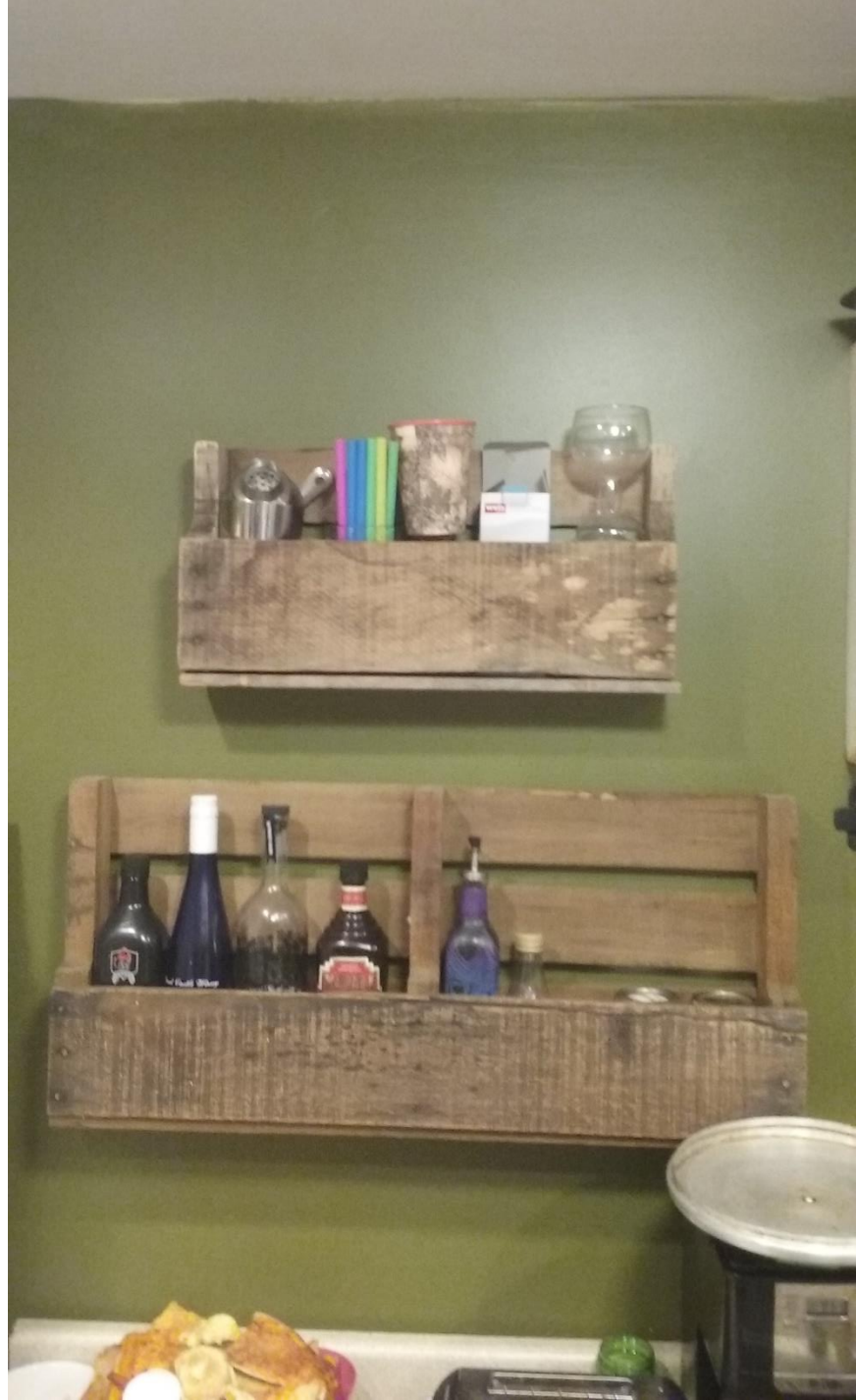


Holiday Upcycling Project
