	117. HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION
1. Authority	The Joint Operating Committee offers the opportunity for homebound instruction in the event of a prolonged, excused absence from school. A doctor's verification is necessary.
	Requests for homebound instruction must be made by the parent/guardian to the sending school guidance department. Approval for such a request must be granted by the sending school Board.
2. Guidelines	The duration of homebound instruction may not exceed forty-five (45) days.
	The goal of the homebound teacher will be to replicate the theory/knowledge portion as much as possible. There will be consistent communication between the homebound teacher and the MCTI teacher(s). The grading process will be a joint effort between the homebound teacher and the MCTI teacher(s).
	An adult family representative must be present to monitor this type of instruction at all times.
