<p>1. Purpose</p> <p>Title 22 Sec. 4.34</p>	<p>A program of guidance counseling is an integral part of the educational program of the school. Such a program can:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Assist students in achieving their optimum potential.2. Enable students to significantly benefit from the program offerings.3. Aid students in recognizing options and making choices in career and technical and academic educational planning.4. Assist students in identifying career options consistent with their abilities and goals.

Authority</p> <p>Title 22 Sec. 4.34, 7.1 et seq</p>	<p>The Joint Operating Committee directs that a program of guidance and counseling shall be offered to all students in the school and shall involve the coordinated efforts of all staff members under the professional leadership of certificated guidance and counseling personnel.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee shall employ a Supervisor of Pupil Personnel Services who shall coordinate the school's guidance program with that of each participating school district.</p> <p>To insure continuity, students will be referred to sending school counselors as assigned.</p>
